Women who are in need of our medical services, along with our other supports. find out about us online and through our socials. Thanks to an amazing crew of tech-savvy volunteers (thank you to Elyssa, Hayley, and Kristine!), we are discovered on myriad platforms and consequently women are connected with our life-saving and hoperecycling services. At this time, we want to share TWO "saves" we have just recently experienced. We hope that you, too, will be uplifted and encouraged as you read these two stories; for, it is due to your support that we are here in the first place and are able to make such an impact!

A woman we will call Elle reached out on Facebook to ask general questions about our services. Our socials team made an instant connection, after which, Elle asked more questions. She had worked in California



prior to moving to the state of Texas; and, she knew from having lived in California that abortion can be obtained in the state up to birth. When she found out she was pregnant, while living in Texas, she returned to California with plans to terminate. That's the precise time she located our info online. She reached out to see if she could speak with someone from our center. Our socials gals spoke with Lori and asked Lori to call Elle. Lori and Elle spoke on the phone for two hours on a Sunday evening. Elle was extremely confused and felt alone making the decision. A texting relationship ensued between Lori and Elle for several days, after which time Elle said she wanted to return to Texas to contemplate having and raising her child. Lori asked if she would like FPRC to connect her with a center like ours in Texas. Elle said that would give her encouragement to be close to another center like ours willing to help her. Lori contacted Save The Storks immediately since FPRC is in the Partner Program with STS. As God would have it, STS was able to connect Elle with another one of their partner centers

in the city where our young client lives. Weeks later, and after much time and care demonstrated by both *Save The Storks* and *Foothills Pregnancy Resource Center*, Elle is continuing with her pregnancy and making plans for her child and their future together. National partnerships with organizations like *Save The Storks* makes all the difference in the lives of the unborn and their mothers! *FPRC* is so grateful that our partnership with *STS* and their coming alongside a client in her most critical hour saved the lives of client and her baby!

Days after *FPRC* learned that all was settled with Elle and that she had made a life-affirming decision for her child, another young client, also from Texas, needed our compassionate care.

A young woman called and told our nurse, Susie, that she had just returned home from Planned Parenthood where she learned she was about 5 weeks pregnant. Susie encouraged the caller to come in for a safe, free ultrasound. But Susie had no sooner hung up from the caller, we'll name her Judith, when Judith's cousin called again. She needed to know that we were going to be a safe place to which she could bring Judith. Susie scheduled an appointment for an ultrasound and consultation. Judith and her cousin arrived to FPRC within the hour instead of going back to Planned Parenthood where Judith had already scheduled an abortion the same day! Susie spent precious time with Judith after which time, she performed an ultrasound. Judith was able to see and hear a fetus and the young mother seemed overjoyed. Most ultrasounds originally take place in privacy between Susie and each client, and in those moments of privacy, Susie posed a thought-provoking question. When Judith told her how confused she was, Susie asked the client how she felt...regardless of the opinions surrounding her. That question made a point with our young client and she realized that what she really wanted was to carry her baby to term. The cousin seemed relieved and began sharing ideas of how she could aid Judith on her journey to parenthood.

Two days after their visit to *FPRC*, Judith's cousin sent an email to Susie and Lori expressing her gratitude for our services and all the care they both had received while at our center. The cousin was praising God that they had even found a job and good housing for Judith, who will not be returning to Texas until after the baby is born!

Through our connection with *Save the Storks*, *Life Advancement Group* has helped guide, create and initially fund our Ads. This has proven very fruitful and allowed us to connect with more clients in critical need with their crisis pregnancy.



Together, we are making a huge difference in the lives of tens of thousands of women. Women who are choosing to parent; women who are wounded after an abortion; women who are making adoption plans for their babies; and women who are just in need of encouragement.

#### YOUR SUPPORT of FPRC means that TOGETHER we are contributing to the following:

IN THE LAST 4 YEARS ALONE, medical pregnancy resource centers have offered FREE support and services:

- 500,000 ultrasounds were conducted totaling \$139 million of assistance
- 160,200 STI's tests were administered totaling \$8 million of valuable help
- 732,000 pregnancy tests administered totaling a value of \$6.5 million
- Parenting and mentoring supports were offered worth \$52 million
- Tens of thousands of men and women wounded by abortion have received help and hope worth \$3.5 million
- 1.5 million diapers have been given out to our moms totaling \$15 million
- Over 2 million outfits for babies and children worth \$10 million have been shared with our clients
- 30,000 car seats and 20,000 strollers worth \$3 million have been shared
