Toddler Behavior - fostering a spirit of cooperation (adapted from Dr. Jordan Peterson)

- Setting boundaries without 'crushing' independence - AND keep to them
 - · Having a sense of humor when child pushes back
 - · Have a set of rules that never change, non-negotiable, enforcing rules
 - · Can I get away with this at grandma's? · Or a friend's house? Everyone should be on the same page
- Teach your child to 'integrate' him/herself, cooperate with others outside home
 - · Catch them cooperating and especially improvement & affirm asap!
 - Friends will help them socialize, welcoming kids into the play group
 - Victory is when your child can regulate themselves, bring themselves under control. Starting with a timer can
 work but then have them decide when they're ready to master his/her emotions
- Make space to master a disciplinary issue
 - O Slot machine addiction! Eventually it pays off - similar to a kid's persistent misbehavior.
 - · Establish 'islands of stability' in a child's life and don't randomly give in.
 - Not too many rules consistently applied, minimal force & plenty of patience
- Don't worry about what others think!
 - Sensitive to the social situation so kids don't attract negative attention
 - Interaction with your child should never be about what others think, attending mostly to what's best for your child, decreasing the self-consciousness you might feel around others.
 - o If you do the right thing for your child, you will be a good example all the way around.
- Don't do tasks for your child that he/she can do themselves.
 - o Fosters & supports independence
 - O Develops a child's confidence reward should be for extra effort
